A Glance at the cause of failure of two Decades US Occupation of Afghanistan

Ashraf Ghani, the national traitor vainly justifies his disgraceful flee and handing over the power to the Taliban:

Five months have passed since the fall of Ashraf Ghani's regime on the 15th of August 2021. The plot to overthrow the regime was going on for several years. It was engineered from within the regime, conspiracy had slowly and steadily caused the terror group of the Taliban to capture Kabul. Evidence suggests that the fall of the regime involved various components. But the majority of analysts and political observers on the development of the situation in Afghanistan consider the main reason for the fall of the system to be related to Ashraf's functions, greed, selfishness, mismanagement and widespread economic, political, social and ethnic corruption within the government.

In the context of recent interviews with the National Security Adviser of Ashraf Ghani, Hamdullah Moheb, with the president's close aides, spokesmen and advisors and with Ashraf Ghani himself, lies and contradictory recountings can be evaluated clearly. Based on the undeniable reasons and evidence, the Ghani's government was one of the most corrupt, incompetent, divisive, fascistic regimes in the history of Afghanistan in general and in the last forty years in particular, which has led the country to instability, economic crisis, poverty, hunger and brain drain.

Ashraf Ghani made significant use of electoral fraud, ethnic divisions, lifethreatening conspiracies against individuals and political opponents. It is necessary to mention some of them briefly. Ashraf Ghani has made significant use of electoral fraud, ethnic divisions, threats and intimidation, conspiracies against individuals and political opponents to gain power. He sacked many professional employees and cadres, especially in the military, political and economic sectors. Ashraf Ghani was incompetent and failed in terms of governance in all areas. He did repeatedly act in violation of the provisions of the law, violated his legal authority and did not observe the constitution, acting as dictator in a tyrannical regime.

Ashraf Ghani was instrumental in handing over power to the Taliban. After meeting with the head of the ISI in 2014, it was agreed to transfer power to the Taliban, provided that he should be assisted to win the presidential election. As a result, with less than a million eligible voters who cast their ballots, the Taliban and Pakistan assisted and abetted widespread electoral fraud enabling Ashraf Ghani to attain power. He sacked over 4000, professional employees and cadres, especially in the military, political and economic sectors.

The Taliban entered Kabul in a pre-managed plot based on the ethnic inclinations of Ashraf Ghani, Hamid Karzai and Zalmay Khalilzad. The regime of Mr Ghani fake republic tumbled. The Taliban entered Kabul palace, without the slightest resistance and declared victory. In a recent interview, Ashraf Ghani blamed the United States and its allies for the collapse of the Afghan regime, which he did not know about until the last moment. He added that he vacated the palace so that Taliban factions, Mullah Baradar from Kandahar and the Haqqani group from Paktia did not get involved in a conflict. He claims he managed to prevent a civil war between the Taliban groups.

According to Dr Abdul Latif Pedram, Chairman of the Afghan National Congress Party, Ashraf Ghani, befell a victim of his misconduct, ethnicity, corruption, and by his two close associates, Hamdullah Moheb and Fazel Mahmoud Fazli. They were inside the presidential palace. "I trusted the Americans too much," Ghani said in an interview with the BBC radio.

In his interview, Ghani, as always, told blatant lies. His sentences tumbled out incongruently and a lot of inconsistency were evident in the interview of Ashrf Ghani and his national security advisor, Moheb. "A national leader who has political rationality and leadership power does not fully trust anyone. Ashraf's words are completely baseless. He did not have popular legitimacy and did not reach the presidency by popular vote, but came to power through fraud. He did not even believe in peace because he wanted to remain in power until the end of his presidency, despite widespread corruption and the inability to lead the country. If he couldn't remain in power, he wanted to hand it over the power only to his people, the Pashtun people, and he did it. All the reasons given by Ashraf

Ghani in his interview were baseless, false and unacceptable to the Afghan people." Said Dr Pedram.

He always bragged proudly and selfishly about his position as commander-inchief of the armed forces, but he was unaware of the fall of Khost province, Jalalabad, or even his guard. This is called "worse excuse than sin" which proves his ineptitude and inability in governing matters. Ashraf Ghani claimed that Amanullah Shah, the former Afghan king, had escaped and that he would not flee. But he, after Sha Shuja and King Amanullah Khan was the third leader in Afghanistan who fled in disgrace and treachery, disrupting the peace process. So how can anyone become the president of a country that knows nothing, according to the Afghan political observers? He was regularly informed and briefed on the security situation by various channels such as the National Security Council, the ministries of Defence and the Interior, the Presidential Guard, and the US Embassy's Foreign Intelligence Service. Ashraf Ghani's claim of ignorance is not justifiable and acceptable, but he tries to acquit himself of his treason, which is not possible.

The delegitimization, the weakening of the troops' morale, the role of regional actors, the role of the United States in the peace talks in the Qatar region, all factors that caused the fall of the regime and the overthrow of the Taliban. Ghani said that international partners are defending our government with all their land and air forces providing all necessary logistics, economic and financial resources. Ghani fired 2,500 military officials and force them to retire. Unemployment rose by 80 per cent. He released 5,000 Taliban from prisons, and all joined the Taliban on the battlefield, helping to strengthen their forces. The United States, Pakistan, Ashraf Ghani, Karzai, Hekmatyar, Khalilzad, the US special envoy, are all to blame.

The US peace plan through Zalmay Khalilzad was a big mistake. The Taliban did not want to join the government. The Americans evacuated Bagram hastily. Khalilzad false claim that the Taliban behaviour has changed, Ashraf Ghani's immense reliance on the United States all accelerated the collapse of the regime.

In a multi-ethnic country, lack of fair participation in power, centralized system contrary to the objective realities of the country, public dissatisfaction, lack of attention to positive and corrective criticisms of civil institutions, lawyers, widespread financial corruption, logistics and customs control, the most corrupt appointments in key positions, the monopoly of financial affairs, the coordination of foreign aids after the Bonn Conference under the authority and management of Ashraf Ghani and widespread corruption, paved the way for the gradual fall of his regime.

In the ongoing peace talks, ridiculous games, betrayal and behind-the-scenes deals were evident, and there was no will for real peace. Ashraf Ghani and his team were corrupt, ethnocentric and fanatical people. He gave millions of dollars to his relatives through contracts based on reliable information, but his economic plan was not right. According to the New York Times, he stole millions of dollars before he left Afghanistan and during his escape.

Brigadier General Piraz Ata Sharifi, was in charge of the day-to-day security of President Ashraf Ghani, claims he not only saw huge bags of cash from the central bank of Afghanistan being transferred to Ghani's control, he has video proof.

Shariff, who was left behind in Afghanistan and is now being hunted by the Taliban, recalled the final day of Ghani's presidency to the Daily Mail from his hideout:

"One of my jobs was to disarm the soldiers on guard at the ministry before the president arrived, for his security," Shariff told the paper. "We were waiting for the president there. But then I got a call to say that instead of coming to the defense ministry, the president had gone to the airport. The defense minister had also fled. So had my boss. So had all of Ghani's close family and entourage."
